



Secondary School Hair and Jewellery Policy

- Hair should be clean and tidy. Extreme hairstyles, which draw attention to the student through cut, colour, additive products, etc., are not permitted (Mohawk haircuts, mullets, rat tails, tracks and other similar cuts are not permitted).
- Fingernails must be clean, well-trimmed and uncoloured. For health and safety reasons no fake nails are permitted. Students may, if they wish, wear light makeup and pale nail polish.
- Acceptable jewellery is unobtrusive and safe. A watch and plain gold or silver coloured sleepers or studs (No birthstones, pearls, diamonds etc.) are permitted. Students are permitted one earring per ear lobe and will be asked to remove all other jewellery. Clear piercing retainers are permitted.

Note: If, in the opinion of the school administration, students do not adhere to these guidelines, they will be required to make the necessary changes to conform to this policy.
